
LOFT





As the world becomes more complex and demanding of time, energy, and money, there is for many a need to reduce and to simplify. The C3 cabin was born out of that desire.

Whereas the footprint may be small, this cabin lives large. With only 352 square feet on the main floor and 128 square feet in the loft, it encompasses all the domestic requirements of structures many times larger.

The design of this cabin is premised on three goals. First, to provide the required spaces for an extended stay cabin within a minimal footprint. Second, provide a quality of space and abundant natural light. And third, to allow for simplicity of construction and maintenance.

Within the sixteen by twenty-two foot outline, the ground floor contains the main living space, kitchen and bath. With doors opening onto three sides the flexibility to connect to multiple outdoor spaces is promoted. The compact kitchen provides for a variety of appliance configurations depending on individual needs. The bath, while compact, contains an over sized shower. The sleeping loft caps both the kitchen and bathroom while open to the living space below.

With multiple operable windows both on the ground floor and in the loft, natural cross ventilation is assured. As a complement to the wood burning stove, heating can be provided by electric coils in the concrete floor or by an on demand hot water system.

Exterior materials were chosen for initial low cost and minimal maintenance over time. Fiber cement and metal panels met both requirements. Both materials are not affected by mold, water absorption or bug infestation, requiring only periodic washing based on the cabin's site conditions.

C3 CABIN | License Agreement

This License Agreement governs the terms and conditions of your use of the design for a vacation cabin (the "Design"), as reflected in the plans and drawings (the "Documents") provided by Vandeventer + Carlander, LLC ("V+C"), by you the purchaser ("licensee") of said plans and drawings.

Grant of License. In exchange for the payment of the license fee, V+C grants you a perpetual, nonexclusive, nontransferable license to use the Design and the Documents for the construction of one structure in the location of your choosing. The license is granted to you only and must not be sold, transferred, assigned, or sub-licensed to anyone else.

Use of the Documents. Together with the grant of the license, V+C will provide the licensee with one copy of the Documents. The Documents may not be resold, and they may not be copied or used for the construction of more than one structure. To the extent that the licensee needs to make copies for the construction of your structure, all copied Documents must include the copyright notice of V+C. The licensee may modify the Design or the Documents in order to conform to local conditions and codes only and for no other purpose.

Ownership. Except for the license granted by this Agreement, V+C retains all right, title and interest in and to the Design and the Documents. The copyright to the Design and the Documents will remain at all times the property of V+C.

Local Conditions. The Design and Documents are representative of local building conditions in the coastal regions of the Pacific Northwest. Local city, county, state, zoning, and building codes of the cabin's actual construction will require modifications or additional documents in order to comply with local regulations. Additional seismic, wind, hurricane, or climactic design may be required in certain regions. It is the licensee's responsibility to have the Design and Documents reviewed by a local professional architect or engineer before the start of construction to confirm that the Design and Documents are appropriate for the specific site and local conditions, or to modify them as necessary. The licensee should check with the local building department to determine if a professional stamp is required on the Documents for permit purposes.

The foundation plan and associated details are provided as a basic guide for a typical spread footing foundation system. The licensee should have a local architect, structural engineer or geotechnical engineer review the Documents to determine if a site-specific foundation design is necessary or appropriate.

The Documents do not include any electrical, plumbing, heating or air conditioning drawings due to the wide variety of local codes and climatic conditions. The licensee should have a local electrical engineer, mechanical engineer or builder provide these drawings as may be required for permits and construction.

The licensee and the licensee's contractor are solely responsible for obtaining any necessary building permits from and inspections by local governmental authorities. It is the licensee's and the licensee's contractor's responsibility to check all dimensions and details for overall accuracy appropriate to the local conditions and the final selection of materials and finishes.

Warranties and Disclaimers. Because of the many variables beyond V+C's control (such as the contractor, materials and site), V+C cannot be responsible for any use that is made of the Design and Documents. The licensee's use or modification of the Design or the Documents is at your the licensee's own risk.

TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, THE DESIGN AND DOCUMENTS ARE PROVIDED TO THE LICENSEE "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF ANY KIND, WHETHER ORAL OR WRITTEN, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED. V+C SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY, SATISFACTORY QUALITY, NON-INFRINGEMENT OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation or enforcement of this Agreement, the prevailing party in that dispute will be entitled to recover its reasonable attorneys' fees and costs.
